BROOKLANDS MUSEUM is a real adventure for all the family with so much to see and do! Brooklands is the world's first purpose-built motor racing circuit and the site of many engineering and technological achievements throughout the 20th Century.

Take any or all of the three trails – **Motoring Village, Test Hill and the Track, Aircraft and Aviation**. Discover the secrets of Brooklands – the place where the great British venture into speed and altitude began over 100 years ago. Let our friendly volunteers answer your questions – *bringing to life the Spirit of Brooklands*.



Cars, motorcycles and bicycles

They all raced at Brooklands. See the banked Race Track and Test Hill and wander through the Motoring Village with its original tuning sheds where record-breaking cars such as Malcolm Campbell's Blue Birds lived. They now house John Cobb's 24-litre Napier-Railton and our extensive collection of racing machines.

Aviation collection

Discover one hundred years of aviation at Brooklands, from the replica of A V Roe's biplane which he used for flight trials here in 1908, to Concorde. Don't miss the Aero Engine display and the Barnes Wallis Stratosphere Chamber and see the giant Vickers Vimy biplane, the aircraft that linked the world.

Don't just look! Board the airliners in the Vickers Aircraft Park – the biggest collection of Vickers and BAC commercial aircraft in the world.

The Brooklands Aircraft Factory and Flight Shed



Discover 80 years of aircraft manufacturing at Brooklands with interactive displays among the museum's collection of aircraft including the Blériot, Vickers Wellington Bomber and Hawker P.1127. A mezzanine floor covering

aviation design and looking over the Aircraft Factory leads to the Flight Shed. This building houses a Harrier and live aircraft that can be wheeled out for engine runs including the Sopwith Camel and Hawker Hurricane. Also, see displays on pioneer pilots, radio and navigation equipment.



School holiday and family activities

During the school holidays, Brooklands is a hive of activity for families. **Come and meet Bertie Bear, discover hidden treasures with educational trails and workshops or take one of our car rides on the famous banked Race Track.**



London Bus Museum

London Bus Museum is operated by the London Bus Preservation Trust. Don't miss this incredible collection of London buses spanning the decades of a bygone era – all included in the admission price.

The Concorde Experience

Discover Brooklands' leading role in the Concorde story by taking the Concorde Experience on board G-BBDG, the first aircraft to carry 100 people at twice the speed of sound and the only Concorde with visitor access in the South East of England. Relive the excitement of the supersonic age and take your seat for your on-board 'flight'. The Concorde Experience is a timed tour and places are limited, so book your tickets on arrival at the Museum to avoid disappointment.
