

BRICK KILN



"This kiln was built in 1940/41 and was used up until 1963"

A major fire destroyed the entire factory and a new factory was built installing electric kilns, the company then no longer required a kiln of this nature. The kiln was built in the evenings by staff who were then working in the factory. The dome was built using no support with just a few rounds of brick being laid every few days.


The kiln was used initially as part of the war effort and fired land drain pipes throughout the Second World War.

METHOD OF OPERATION - The kiln was designed as a down draft kiln which meant that the heat would not be released from the dome but would be drawn back down through the kiln load into the floor to the central flue which went underground and up the chimney stack. A large damper was used in the base of the chimney stack to control the draft.
