Thursday 14th September 7.30 pm



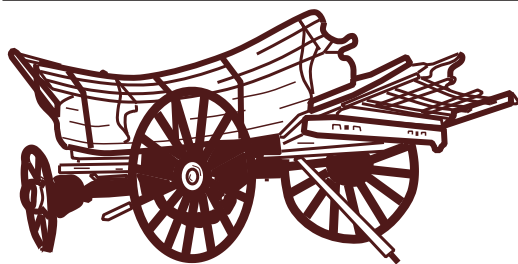
Jeremy Harte, Curator of the Bourne Hall museum in Epsom, gives a talk about the varied history of the Romany people and their culture.
