HOW TO FIND US (SAT NAV YO17 8NG)


Scampston is on the north side of the A64 York/Scarborough road, 5 miles east of Malton.

BY CAR

From the York direction, half a mile after the traffic lights in the village of Rillington take the left turn, signed Scampston Only and follow signs to the Walled Garden.

BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Yorkshire Coastliner (01653 692556) Bus services 843, 845 and X45 pass within 1 mile of the Garden. Nearest train station: Malton
