- Catch the 508 bus back to Penrith



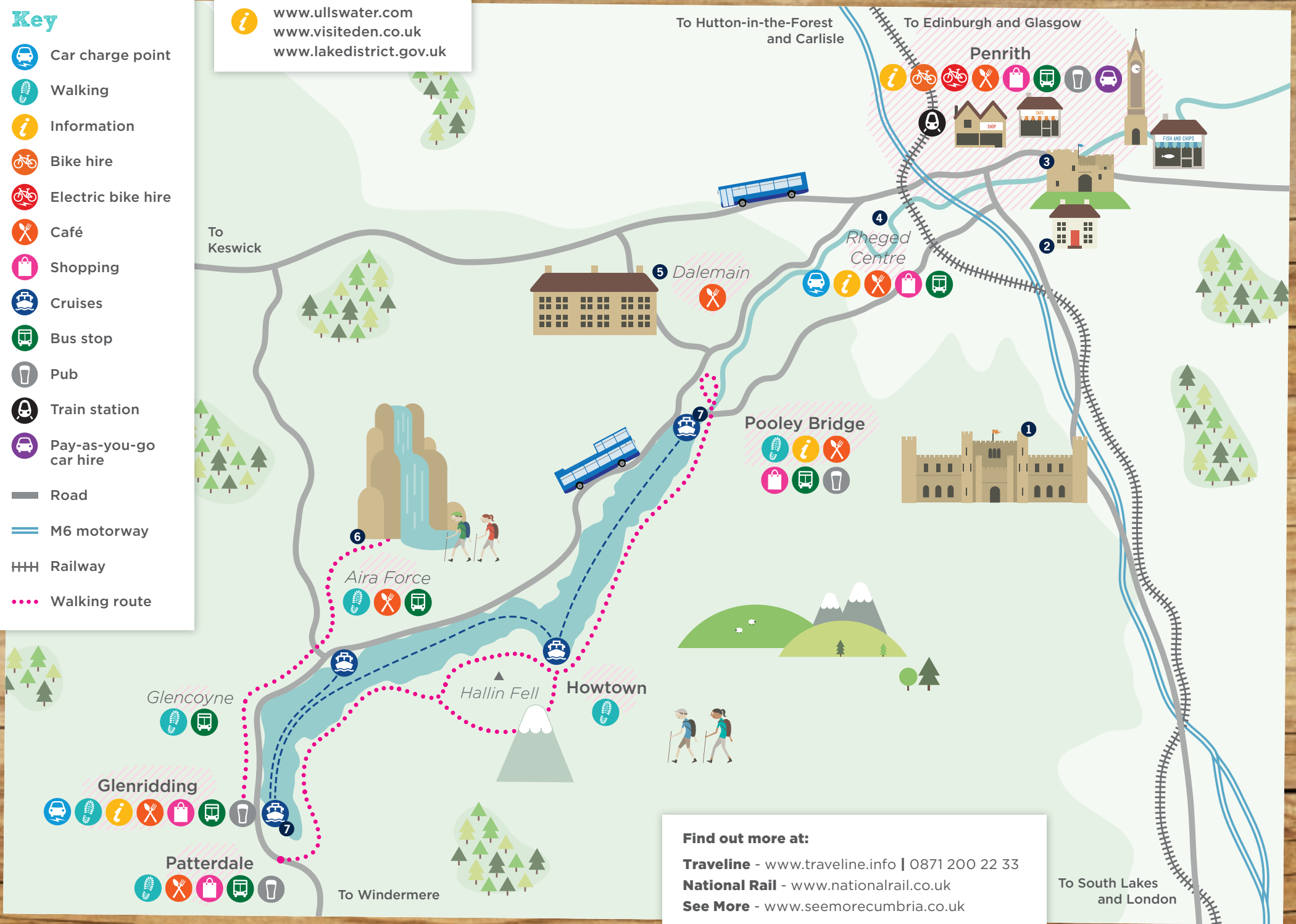
