LONGLEAT HOUSE

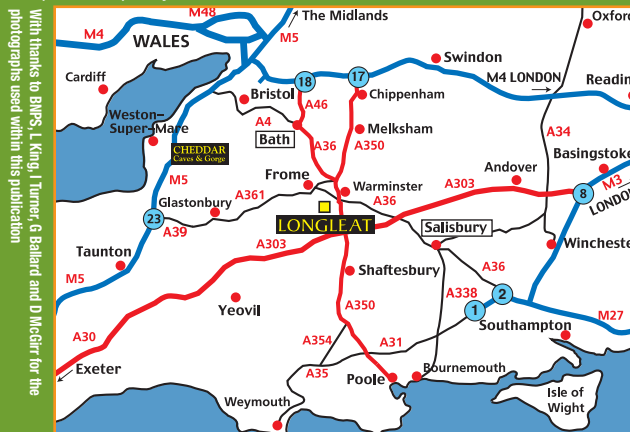
10am to 5pm (5.30pm on weekends, Bank Holidays and during state school holidays)*
Longleat House is also open 22nd February to 26th March (Mondays to Fridays only). Guided tours at 12pm and 2pm only.

ALL OTHER ATTRACTIONS

11am to 5pm (10.30am to 5.30pm on weekends, Bank Holidays and during state school holidays)*

* All attractions may close earlier due to shorter daylight hours in Feb, March and October.

- The Longleat Passport Ticket offers once-only entry into all 11 of the Longleat attractions on any day during the 2010 season... there is no additional charge to come back AND you can visit the Longleat Grounds as often as you like!
- Soft top cars, cars with vinyl sunroofs and motorbikes etc., are not permitted in the Safari Park. A limited daily Safari Bus service, at an additional cost and subject to availability, can be booked from Visitor Information for visitors with any of the above or who travel to Longleat by public transport. The Safari Bus service cannot be booked in advance of your visit so please arrive early
- During school holidays and at busy times the tour of Longleat House will be restricted for conservation reasons
- During school holidays and at busy times the Safari Park may be closed for short periods during the day to help avoid the build up of traffic
- Longleat welcomes all visitors. Please telephone and request the Map and Access leaflet for details on accessibility into individual attractions
- Dogs on leads are allowed in the grounds only. They are not allowed in the attractions (not applicable to Service Dogs). Free kennelling is available during your Safari Park visit only. Service Dogs are not allowed in the Safari Park, Motion Simulator, Butterfly House or Old Joe's Mine
- Longleat offers special rates for 12+ paying people. It is a splendid venue for corporate hospitality

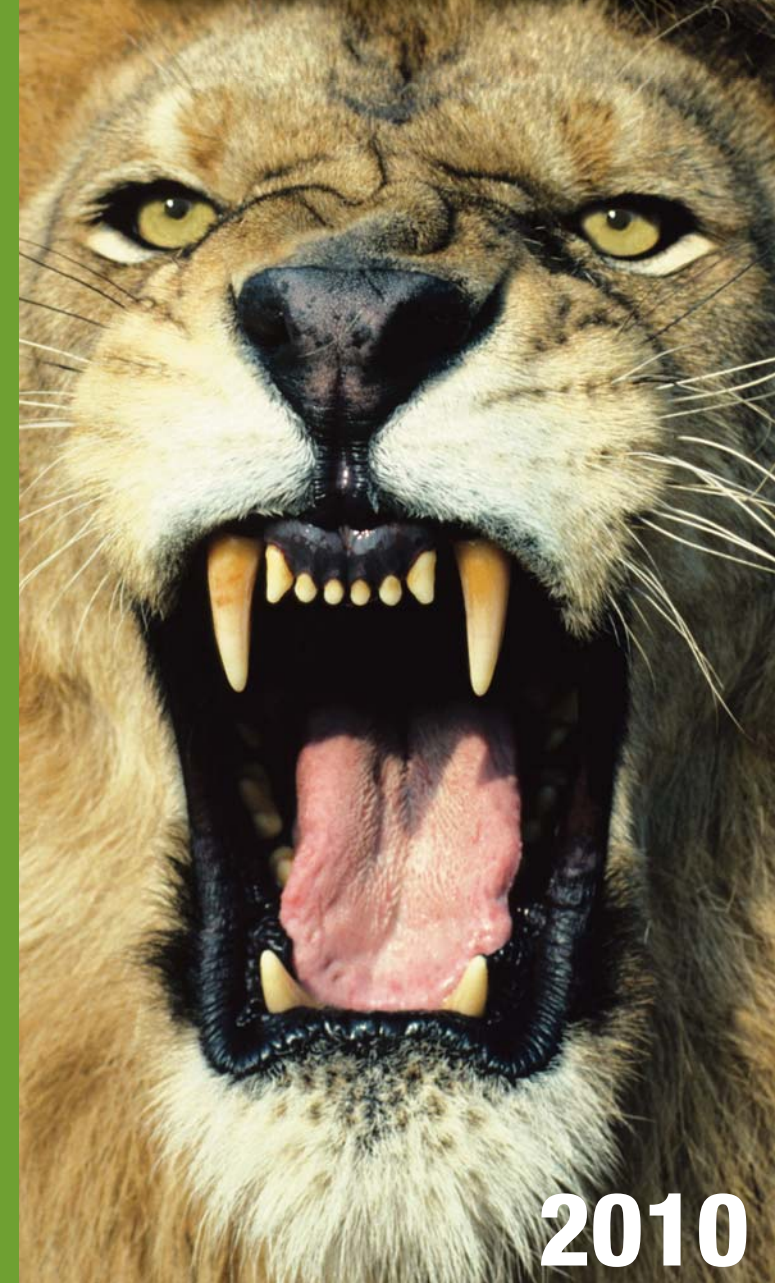

Longleat has to be the place to take family and friends in 2010 as there really is oodles to keep you entertained throughout the year.

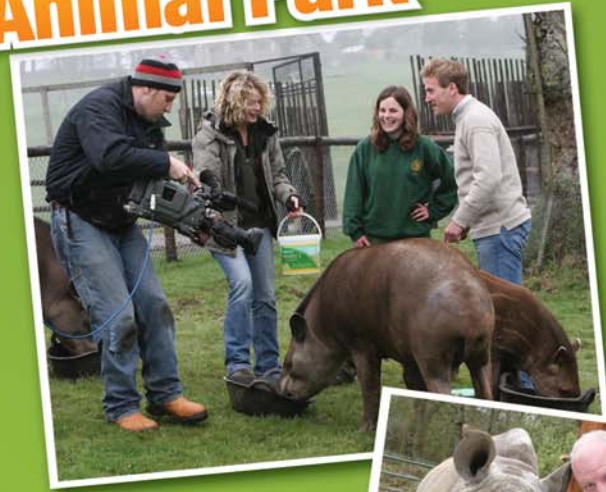

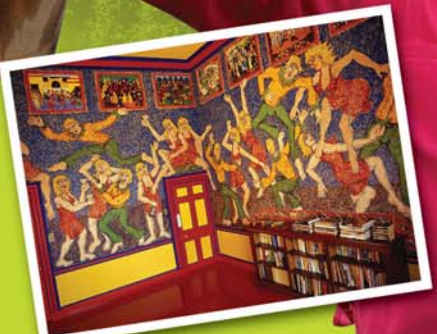

As Animal Adventure Opens...

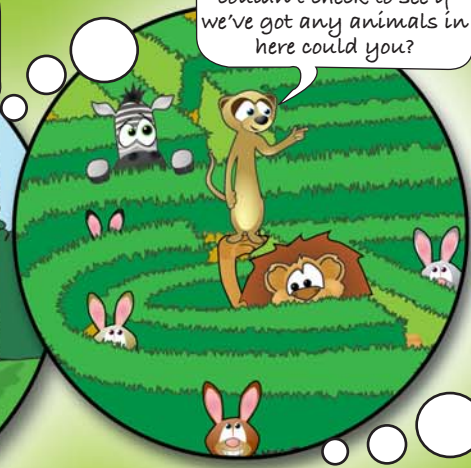


Oh No! Where are all the animals, they should be here by now. I'd better go and find them before we open.

I did spot a tortoise in with the giraffe. Bear with me and I'll go and get him.



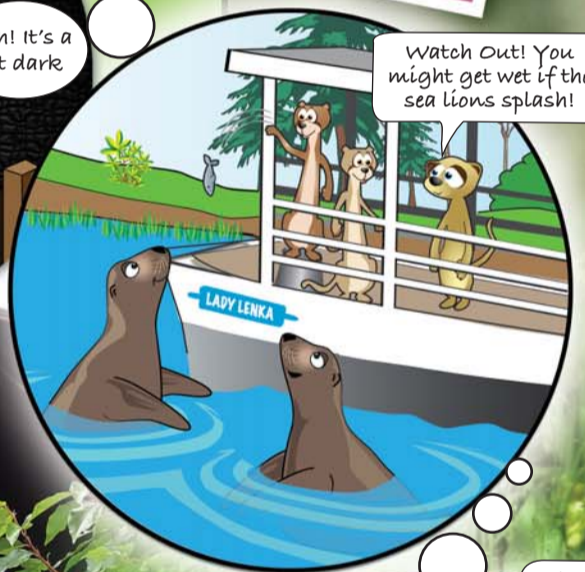
The Hedge Maze is likely to get them lost. You couldn't check to see if we've got any animals in here could you?

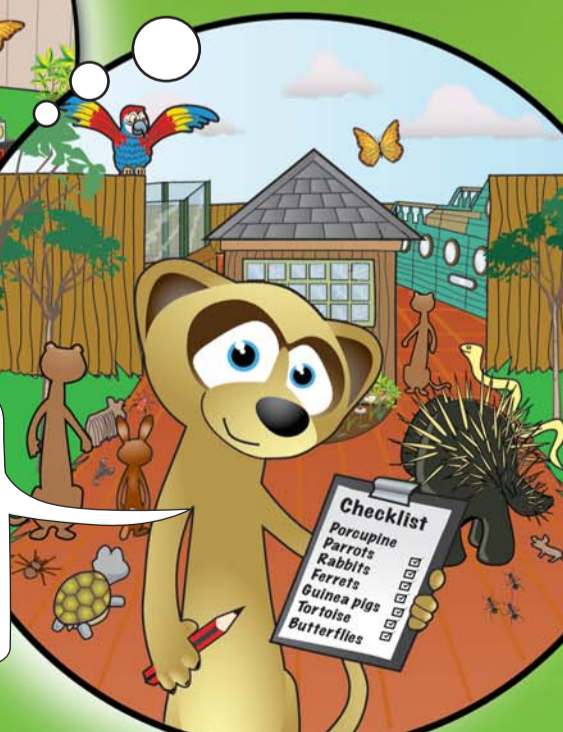
Please note that some attractions have height / age restrictions
